Significant events:

The final cleanup from the water of the October 24, 2021 storm is complete. There are still two vessels on the boat ramp at the Army Corps of Engineers Debris dock awaiting disposal.

Three new vessels arrived in the anchorage during this period. One of the vessels has already been removed as marine debris and is awaiting disposal, the other two remain.

One additional vessel was removed from the anchorage as marine debris and has been disposed of.

Three vessels are in the queue for the Voluntary Turn in Program, one from the anchorage, one from a resident in Mill Valley, and one as part of interagency cooperation outside of Richardson's Bay.

The Richardson's Bay Eelgrass Preservation and Restoration project has been adopted for approval as a planning project by the San Francisco Bay Joint Venture. This enables the Joint Venture to support our project as we seek funding for future eel grass initiatives.
